

Equipment Selection Checklist

A site brief for comparing MRCH cleaning machines.

1. Describe the job

- ☐ Record indoor/outdoor use, floor finish, debris and cleaning frequency.
- ☐ Measure usable floor area, narrowest opening, turns, ramps and storage access.
- ☐ Identify the available cleaning window and pedestrian or forklift traffic.

2. Choose a starting category

- ☐ Compare scrubbers for wet cleaning of compatible hard floors; sweepers for loose dry debris.
- ☐ Compare walk-behind machines for restricted routes and ride-on models for longer open routes.
- ☐ For vacuum collection, identify the material first; confirm the required filter and collection system.

3. Compare the actual configuration

- ☐ Record cleaning-path width separately from squeegee width and overall machine width.
- ☐ Compare solution/recovery tanks or waste-container capacity, dimensions and power supply.
- ☐ Ask which battery, charger, brushes, pads, filters and accessories are included.

4. Prepare the quotation request

- ☐ List candidate model, quantity, delivery destination and requested documents.
- ☐ Allow for turns, refilling, emptying and charging when estimating shift output.
- ☐ Record unresolved specifications in writing before selecting the configuration.

Planning aid, not a model specification sheet. Numerical values must come from the selected MRCH model and confirmed quotation.
