

Floor Scrubber Care Checklist

A daily inspection prompt for operators and facility teams.

1. Before cleaning

- ☐ Read the selected machine manual and inspect the route before use.
- ☐ Inspect brushes/pads, squeegee blades, hoses and visible connections for wear or damage.
- ☐ Check the specified battery/charger configuration and choose approved floor-care consumables.

2. During operation

- ☐ Watch for streaks, poor pickup, unusual noise, leaks or warning indicators.
- ☐ If performance changes, stop in a safe place and follow the manual before inspection.
- ☐ Do not override guards or warnings, or use the machine for unidentified hazardous materials.

3. After use

- ☐ Drain and rinse tanks and clean removable debris screens as directed in the model manual.
- ☐ Remove debris from the cleaning head and squeegee; inspect wear before the next shift.
- ☐ Follow the battery manufacturer instructions for charging, ventilation and storage.

4. Record and follow up

- ☐ Log model, serial number, date, operating hours and the observed symptom.
- ☐ Take a clear photo of the affected part and record recent consumable changes.
- ☐ Arrange service for damage or persistent faults; do not treat a checklist as repair instructions.

General care aid, not an MRCH operating or service manual. Procedures and intervals depend on the model, battery and use conditions.
